Christophe Guye Galerie is pleased to announce a new solo exhibition by Japanese photographer and Zen monk Syoin Kajii. Entitled Nami, Kawa, Tsuki – Wave, River, Moon – the show features around 20 works, including large-scale photographs and a video installation. Many of the pieces were created in 2024 and 2025 and will be shown to the public for the first time.

Born in 1976 in Tokushima, Japan, Kajii is known for his contemplative images of natural phenomena, particularly the sea. His work is held in major public collections, including the permanent collection of the Rijksmuseum Amsterdam. His acclaimed Nami series was awarded the Kimura Ihei Award in 2004.

With Nami, Kawa, Tsuki, Kajii expands his perspective: alongside waves (nami), he now turns his attention to rivers (kawa) and moonlit scenes (tsuki). His photographs blend spiritual presence with visual precision – images that are not merely representations, but distilled experiences.

The exhibition opens on Wednesday, 27 August 2025, with a public reception. Collectors, curators, journalists and all interested guests are warmly invited.
